MINUTES OF THE 18TH ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 15TH OCTOBER 2020 in THE BOARD ROOM for THE ODD SEMESTER 2020-21

Time: 11.30 AM

Follow up of the previous Academic Council Meet.

1. As per the recommendations, the TANSCHEGuidelines have been incorporated for all UG courses in the institution from Academic Year 2020 – 21.
2. 10% revision in the courses was recommended, 20% revision has been incorporated in all the programs.
3. The evaluation term “Internal Assessment” was asked to be rephrased as “Continuous Internal Assessment” and it is rephrased as suggested from the Academic year 2020onwards
4. The suggestion to introduce NPTEL/ MOOC courses in the curriculum is put into operation in the form of Extra Credits from the Academic Year 2020 – 21.

COMMON POINTS DISCUSSED

- ◆ Madurai Kamaraj University Nominee, Dr.Chellaih, recommended the department of MBA to reduce the credit distribution for their programme from 122 to 102 .As AICTE recommended credit is 102.
- ◆ The department of MBA Head of the Department elaborated the curriculum design and agreed to reduce the credits in the curriculum and give other courses as extracredits.
- ◆ Mr.Chellaih again suggested to offer only 10 for obtaining an MBA degree.
- ◆ Mr.Kumaresan, MKU Nominee recommended keeping the latest edition for reference books for all courses especially Mathematics.
- ◆ Mr.Chelliah and Mr.Swamikannan asked the Computer Science department to keep the nomenclature as B.Sc.Computer Science and to keep SSS courses in the specialization stream this is for equivalency purposes.
- ◆ Dr.Swamikannan recommended B.Com (B&I) to keep 75% B.Com syllabus and 25% specialization syllabus as per TANSICHE norms. This was recommended to meet out equivalency problem for the course.
