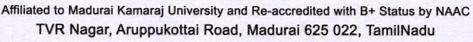

Objectives of the Research Policy

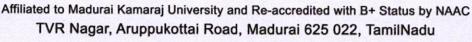
- To supervise Research activities in the institute

Faculty members pursuing Ph.D. Programme can avail a maximum of 15 days On Duty per year with a split-up of 8 days and 7 days for Odd and Even Semesters respectively and this cannot be carried forward from one semester to another semester on any account.

This can be availed with the following conditions for a maximum of 4 years irrespective of the faculty members' actual year of Ph.D. completion.

Option - II

1 The management is also pleased to extend financial assistance to ensure the smooth progress of faculty members' Ph.D endeavors.

- The management extends financial assistance which would be proportionate to the 15 days gross salary of the respective PhD pursuing A faculty member.
- This financial assistance can be availed by them for a maximum of 4 years (Each year 15 days of gross salary will be given as financial assistance for a maximum of 4 years)

Note:

- a) The faculty members completing their Ph.D. by means of this financial assistance should compulsorily extend their service to the institution for a minimum of 3 years.
- b) In the event of any violation, it will be mandatory for the faculty concerned to pay back the amount received from the management.
- c) However, during their compulsory extension period, if any unsatisfactory ~ performance of faculty members is taken cognizance of, the management will be constrained to terminate the service of the faculty members spy forthwith.
- d) This service termination will also entail them to pay back the amount received from the management.

Note:

Faculty members wishing to opt for either of the options will be required to submit an Undertaking Letter to the management stating their acceptance and adherence to the conditions stated above.

 It is not compulsory for faculty members to opt for the above-mentioned options to pursue their Ph.Ds.

Note:

- a) To promote more PhD Holders, faculty members who have availed themselves of this Duty provision to complete the Ph.D. programme successfully will be required to extend their service to the institution for a minimum of 3 years after completing Ph.D. in lieu of the support extended by the management.
- b) This three-year compulsory extension period commences only on the date of submission of Ph. D Provisional Certificate by the faculty concerned to the institution.
- c) In the event of any violation, it will be mandatory for the faculty concerned to pay his/her salary amount to the institution, proportionate to the number of days of On Duty availed during his/her Ph.D. pursuing period.
- d) However, during their compulsory extension period, if any unsatisfactory performance of faculty members is taken cognizance of, the management will be constrained to terminate the service of the faculty members forthwith.
- e) This service termination will also entail them to pay their salary amount to the institution proportionate to the number of days of On Duty availed.

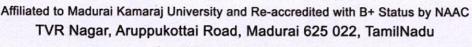
Consultancy Policy
